



## DDP and Archiware – Licenses and Sales Opportunities

Every DDP storage solution now comes with Archiware P5 pre-installed and a license included.

### What does this license give the customer?

1. It is for **Archiware P5 Backup**. This is only one module of the P5 suite.
2. It is limited to a **standalone tape drive** (not for libraries and multiple drives)
3. There is **no limit to the number of tapes** that can be read/written

### What is Backup?

A backup is a **secondary copy** of the data used in production (on the DDP storage). It represents a **safety net** in case data is lost, damaged or deleted. In this case, the backed up data can be restored to replace that data.

However, backup is a **cyclic process**. Previous backups are **regularly overwritten** when the retention time is reached.

Backing up data **will not create an Archive!**

### What is Archive?

An Archive is the **long-term preservation** of completed productions, media and other files. As these files are no longer needed on a daily basis, but should nevertheless be kept for future reference, re-purposing etc. They are **migrated** from the DDP production storage to the Archive. This saves space and cost. Additionally P5 Archive provides metadata fields, thumbnails and clips to find files easier.





In many cases, the data is moved to LTO tape, often within a tape library. Archived data is **never overwritten** automatically.

### Options to extend the included Archiware P5 license:

- Tape automation/Tape library (plus options for multiple tape drives)
- Number of slots within tape libraries
- **P5 Archive**: long-term data preservation, metadata fields, thumbnails, preview clips, search and restore of archived media
- **P5 Synchronize**: data cloning for immediate failover or for collaborative work, data sync to and from cloud storage
- **P5 Data Mover**: P5 Archive add-on for policy-based moving and copying of archived data to disk, tape and cloud.
